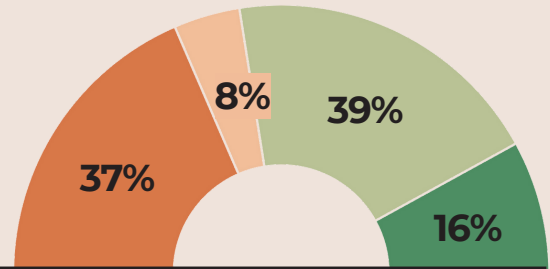

Since its inception, GCF has relied on its donor-advisors to recommend hundreds of worthwhile charities who use their grants to improve the lives of citizens from Georgia and other states.

2023 IMPACT OF KEY PROGRAMS



GOAL raised \$52.4 million in contributions and issued 9,703 scholarships totaling \$49.6 million.
